However the Medal/Rosette will still be offered to the foal and youngstock classes. I hope to see you all there. I have included the schedule with this Newsletter.

The year started with the AGM in March. We had good attendance, even members from Scotland.

After the usual officer's reports from Gary Atkinson our Chairperson and Kathryne Cubello our Show Secretary/ Treasurer, we discussed the Website and the fact that it was not kept up to date. Gary agreed that as not everyone had "facebook" that it should indeed be the first place to have all information and schedules added and as long he was given the information as soon as it was available he would update it.

Most of the shows we ran last year came in at a loss, with fewer entries and with the rising cost of hiring venues. It was suggested we run some fund raising events.

A stud visit was suggested and an online photo competition. We do have our Christmas party which normally brings in a profit. This year's Party will be on Saturday 6th December at the usual venue Coxhoe WMC Ticket order form is at the end of this newsletter. We will have some tickets on sale at the Foal show. We have kept the prices at the same price as last

year. £7 Adults and £4.50 for Children. This event is very popular so get your tickets early.

Sponsorship was another suggestion and we have tried in the past. Our 2 day show last year was very well sponsored. Thank you for all donations.

Our new Show secretary who is also our current Treasurer Kathryne Cubello .

Kathryne has already overseen the Youngstock, Spring Show and Summer Show Not having done this before she is keen to learn and any suggestions would be greatly appreciated.

We do have a rather large cost of hiring a printer to print all of our schedules and catalogues. We are in a contract with the current supplier and Kathryne was to look into this. In the meantime Norma would approach the NPS and the NCPA committee's and ask if they would be willing to share the cost. Since then I am pleased to report that NCPA have agreed and we are still awaiting the decision from NPS

Two of our committee indicated that they wished to retire. Alison Duval due to work commitments and a house move. Good luck to Alison and her family in their new home and I'm sure we will be seeing her and Emma at our future shows.
