Although there were no medals on offer we did hold the usual welsh only classes and in fact our in hand Champion came from the section D class ably shown by Mr John Bennett, who only decided to attend the night before (the advantage of having all entries on the day of the show) with the reserve championship going to Karen and Steven Kirby's Hillview Lad. Ridden Champion and Overall Supreme went to Laura Hudson's Angrove Rumbaba, her own very unusual coloured thoroughbred. Reserve supreme also from the ridden section was Taylor Brown riding Miss Charlotte Millers fell pony Rundales Mayfly. 1st Reserve was Miss Grace Philips Coffeepot Buccaneer.
