## Correspondence

I had received several letters most importantly from the WPCS. The first regarding entries on the day. From 2019 affiliated shows will no longer be able to accept entries on show day. We never adopted this as we voted not to, so it won't affect us. In addition, all animals must be registered with the Society and have their registration name and number included on their application form. The other letter from WPCS was regarding Silver Medal Status. The Judging and showing committee held a meeting in October 2017 and will be reviewing all silver medal shows in 2018 and decided that if we don't meet the criteria will be considered for a bronze medal show upon application.

We have been proud to offer a silver medal show and hope we have done enough to hold on to it. We won't know until we receive confirmation. It is up to our members and competitors to support all of our shows to make it worth the cost of offering these medals.

A form was received for anyone wishing to attend a meeting of area association representatives on the day of the AGM to be held at 10 am before the AGM Unfortunately no one was available to attend. This is an annual event, should anyone wish to attend in future please contact any committee member and it will be arranged.

We were invited by the North Western WPCA to take part in their Championship show in August 2018 with a cash prize the Supreme and Reserve In Hand would qualify. We did agree to participate.

A letter of resignation from Committee was received from Joanne Walton. Joanne has been a valued member of the committee for the last years however her personal commitments meant that she no longer felt that she could continue. We thanked her and presented her with a lovely plant and hoped she would continue to support the shows in future.

There were 2 nominations to join the committee Sue Daggett nominated by Ann Barker and Ashleigh Ball nominated by Ruby Williams. As there were no other nominations We later invited Sue and Ashleigh to join the committee.
