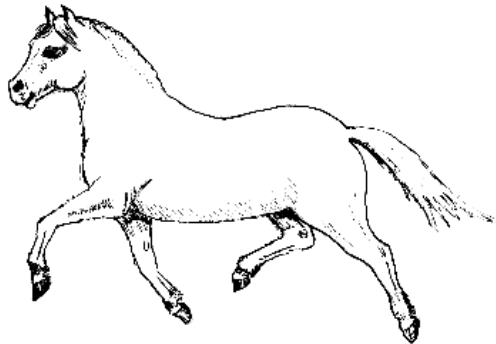

TSR Riders & In Hand Showing Finals – This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots - With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final.

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes Show Number TGCA/08/17/122

Pure Bred classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob, a minimum of 50% breeding is accepted.

Stallions (pure or [part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook). For **Quest Championship Shows** Inhand and Ridden

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

TGCA . And for **Glory Championships** Inhand and Ridden

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA Part Bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship, for 2018 and 2019 TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championship at TOYS

"This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 18148 Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 30th August-1st September 2018. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK).
All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception

Working Hunter Horse/Pony, Stallion Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Rider any age. These classes are designed to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly.

Method of Judging:

1. Horse/Ponies will enter the ring individually and jump a course of obstacles designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts. Course Builders are recommended to avoid fences with a related distance.
2. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 – at the judge's discretion.
3. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out but three refusals will result in elimination.
4. Fall of horse or rider will result in elimination.
5. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark of 20 will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round.
6. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placing's. Should there still be an equality of marks, the jumping marks will be taken into consideration – the comparison beginning with fence one and continuing thereafter until a result is achieved.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All animals to be registered in the appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry
3. The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class/classes
4. On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal
5. All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. They must be licensed as per their appropriate breed society.
6. All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA and winners are responsible for their safe return
7. The judges decision is FINAL
8. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground
9. Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge, any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal. If no vet is available, the judge's decision is final. (All vet's fees paid by exhibitor)
10. Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL
11. The committee will deal with all disputes relating to the Association and their decision being final and binding without any appeal to law
12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE
13. All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show
14. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the approved BSI standard VG1 or PAS015 2011 should be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children under 16 years whilst in the ring.
15. **Policy for closing rings:**
IN HAND – When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.
RIDDEN - When the class goes into trot
16. Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximate, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee accepts no responsibility should they clash
17. The Association, committee, assistants or stewards shall in no way be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused
18. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee
19. All ridden ponies must be four years old & over
20. Ridden Stallions - Sections A & B to be ridden by children 12 years old & over. Sections C & D to be ridden by children 14years old & over.
21. Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker. It is recommended that In Hand Stallions also display a bridle marker.
22. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced
23. Dogs must be kept on the lead at all times
