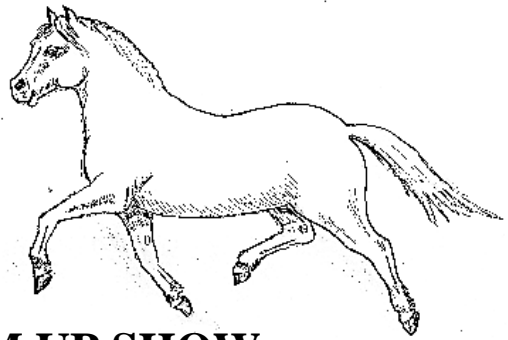

Qualifier for TSR Showing Finals

TSR Riders & In Hand Showing Finals – This show is a qualifier for the 2017 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish.

You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

Classes 1 – 4 are qualifiers for **Spillers/Equifest mountain & Moorland in Hand**

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C & D. Stallion, Mare, Colt, Filly or Gelding any age.

CLASS 1	Youngstock Section A & B, Colt, Filly or Gelding
CLASS 2	4 years and over Section A & B, Stallion, Mare or Gelding
CLASS 3	Youngstock Section C & D, Colt filly or Gelding
CLASS 4	4 years and over Section C & D, Stallion Mare or Gelding
CLASS 5	Welsh Part Bred Any Age

M & M SECTION (excluding Welsh)

Classes 6 – 9 are qualifiers for **Spillers/Equifest mountain & Moorland in Hand**

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Stallion, Mare, Colt, Filly or Gelding any age.

CLASS 6	Youngstock Small Breeds, Colt, Filly or Gelding
CLASS 7	4 years old and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding
CLASS 8	Youngstock Large Breeds, Colt, Filly or Gelding
CLASS 9	4 years old and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding

COLOURED SECTION

Classes 10 – 13 are qualifiers for **BSPA/EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD/SKEWBALD**

Open In Hand Piebald/Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their Show rules & conditions

CLASS 10	Youngstock Traditional/Native/Gypsy Cob, colt Filly or Gelding
CLASS 11	4 Yr Old & over Traditional/Native/Gypsy Cob, Stallion, Mare or Gelding
CLASS 12	Youngstock Non Native, colt Filly or Gelding

CLASS 28	NOVICE HORSE/PONY in first year of competing – walk and trot Only
CLASS 29	NOVICE RIDER in first year of competing – walk and trot only

RULES

- 1 The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate or split any class or classes.
- 2 The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 3 On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, Sold or produced that animal.
- 4 All colts and stallions over 2 years old must be correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.
- 5 The judge's decision is FINAL
- 6 Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the showground.
- 7 Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound.
- 8 It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.
- 9 Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the current VG1 or PAS015 2011 must be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by Juniors whilst in the ring
- 10 Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximated.
- 11 Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to Leave the showground immediately by the committee.
- 12 All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
- 13 The Association, Committee, assistants or stewards shall be in no way held responsible for any Loss, damage, injury howsoever caused
- 14 **Stallions** – riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday in the current year for ponies not exceeding 138cms or 14th birthday for stallions over 138cm in any current year.
- 15 All ridden horses/ponies must be 4 years old & over.
